OBJECTIVE

Baseline study:

Main objective of baseline study is to collect factual and other information from villages of 2 Drought Prone districts & 2 Flood Prone districts of Bihar to identify needs and requirements of the places, so that the existing gaps can be bridged by developing projects to address demands coming from people

BASELINE SURVEY DESIGN

- **Village Profiling:**

Meeting with PRI members (Triangulation of collected information)

- **Drawing of Social Map**

As per the information gathered from PRIs and others Meeting

- **House Hold Selection**

Selection of HH from each SHG of Village, random selection of 5 HH from each direction including centre

INTERVIEW TECHNIQUES

Methods:

- Quantitative technique will be used to collect data from HH and Qualitative from PRI & Other Members
- Structured interview schedules, face-to-face interaction with respondents

Data Quality:

- To ensure the data quality 4 field supervisor will be deployed, 1 in each district as DQA person who will be responsible for team movement, spot check and editing of schedule on daily basis and will monitor overall data collection activity during fieldwork. 10% of the data will be verified by supervisor on random basis everyday.
- Data entry will be done in specific software package of CSPro. Statistical Package for Social Sciences (SPSS) software will be used for data analysis
- Man Power- 6 graduate & Qualified in each district to collect information from field to carry out study
- 5-6 HH survey in a day by each surveyor (To get detailed information as per requirement)

ETHICS

Considerations:

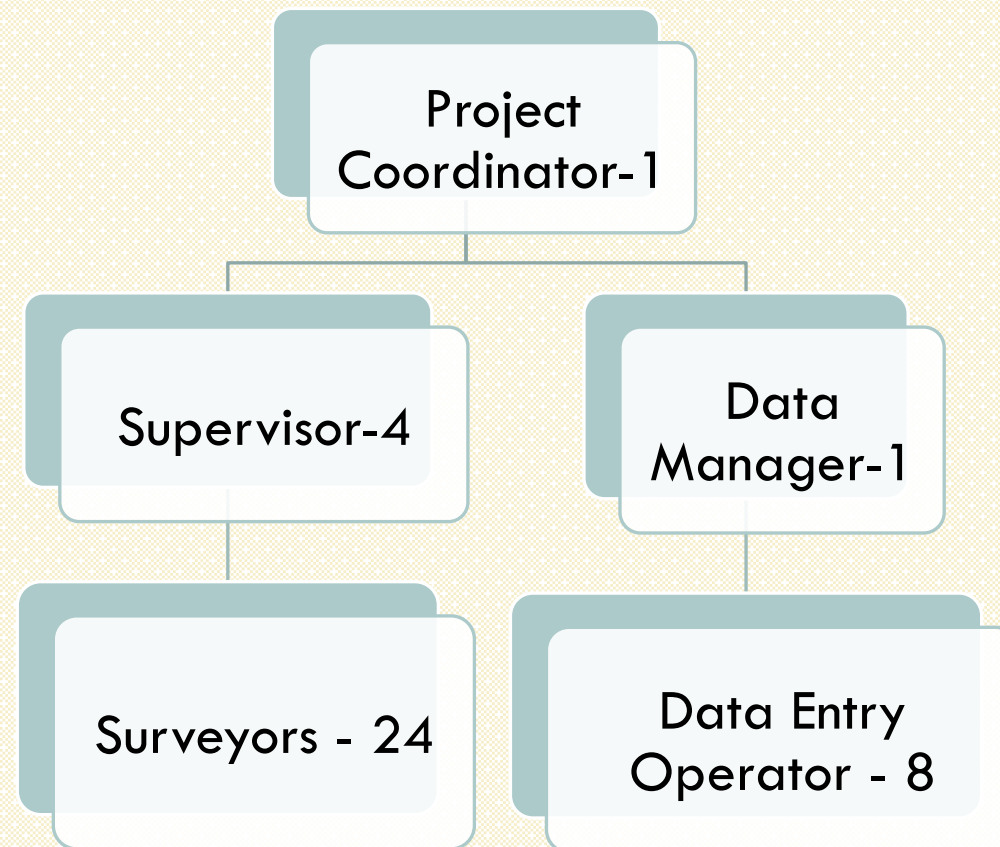
Before conducting the HH survey and KII, consideration will be taken from the other part to avoid any confusion or dispute.

The most common method to remain ethical in social and economical survey is 'informed consent'. Standard ethical consent form (as used in national survey) will be used and only consenting person will be interviewed.

ANTICIPATED PROBLEMS

Problem and difficulty may occur during fieldwork, due to rainy season & geographical allocation of the study areas is undulating. In such situation, investigators must be familiar to the field as well as location to make it simple. It is also important to understand the heat waves & Monsoon Season both will fall in between (May - Aug), data collection work needs to be handled properly.
